

Title: An Ordinance annexing to the Town of Redmond certain Contiguous real property, known as "Redmond Gardens", a more particular legal description of which is annexed hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

WHEREAS, a petition has been presented to the Town Clerk of Redmond, who has presented same to the Town Council of Redmond, which Council has entertained said petition, and by Resolution has caused a notice of Public Meeting to be published and posted, said petition praying for the annexation to the Town of Redmond of that area contiguous to the said Town, and a legal description of which is annexed hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, and

WHEREAS, a public meeting has been held, after the due notice by publication and posting above referred to, and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Town Council of the Town of Redmond that the annexation prayed for would be to the best interests of the Town of Redmond,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Redmond:

Section 1. That the area known as ^{PART OF} "Redmond Gardens", a legal description of which area is annexed hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, as though set forth fully, be and the same is hereby annexed to the Town of Redmond.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the 16th day of April, 1951.

BOUNDARY OF PROPOSED ANNEXATION
TO THE TOWN OF REDMOND

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 1, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M., thence Northerly along the West boundary of said Section 1 to the Northwest corner of said Section 1, thence Easterly along the North boundary of said Section 1 to the East boundary of the West 1/2, ^{OF} West 1/2, of the Northeast 1/4 of said Section 1, thence Southerly along said East boundary to the South boundary of the Northeast 1/4 of said Section 1, thence South 78°21'13" East 174.27 feet, thence South 38°21'20" West 600 feet, thence Westerly 457.06 feet to a point on the West boundary of the Southeast 1/4 of said Section 1, said point being 495.84 feet south of the Northwest corner of said Southeast 1/4 of Section 1, thence Southerly along the West boundary of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 1 to a point 330 feet North of the South boundary of said Section 1, thence Westerly parallel to the South boundary of said Section 1 to a point on the West boundary of the East 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of said Section 1, thence Northerly along said West boundary to the Northeast corner of the West 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of said Section 1, thence Westerly along the North boundary of the Southwest 1/4, ^{OF THE} Southwest 1/4 of said Section 1 to a point 330 feet East of the West boundary of said Section 1, thence Northerly parallel to the West boundary of said Section 1 to the North boundary of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 1, thence Westerly along the North boundary of said ^{SW 1/4 OF} Section 1 ^{A DISTANCE OF} 330 feet to the Southwest corner of the Northwest 1/4 of said Section 1 the true point of beginning. All in Section 1, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M., King County, Washington.
