

TOWN OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 148

AN ORDINANCE ratifying the Calls for Bids on the construction of additions and betterments to and extensions of the Waterworks Utility System of the Town of Redmond, and accepting the bids of Kirkland Sand and Gravel Co., and H. D. Fowler Co.

WHEREAS, on April 14, 1951 the Town Clerk gave notice by publication in the form and manner required by law that sealed bids would be received at the Redmond Town Hall until 8:00 P.M., April 25, 1951, for furnishing material of the following approximate quantities:

Cast iron or asbestos cement pipe
600 linear feet of 8" pipe
7900 Linear feet of 6" pipe
970 linear feet 4" pipe
11 standard fire hydrants
19 gate valves of various sizes
19 valve boxes,

WHEREAS, bids were duly opened at the time and place stated in said Notice, and the unit price bid of H. D. Fowler Co., in the total sum of \$13,029.30 for the 8", 6" and 4" cement asbestos pipe, and in the sum of \$2,809.00 for the 11 hydrants, 19 valves and 19 valve boxes was the lowest and best bid received for said materials,

WHEREAS, on the 26th day of April, 1951, the Town Clerk gave notice by publication in the form and manner required by law that sealed bids would be received at the Town Hall, Redmond until 8:30 P.M., Daylight Savings Time, May 9, 1951, for the installation of a water distribution system to consist of the following

Schedule A- Approximately 10,000 feet 8", 6" and 4" pipe and dual pump station.
Schedule B- Furnish and install dual 4" pressure reducing station.
Schedule C- 250,000 gal on storage tank base,

WHEREAS, bids were duly opened at the time and place stated in said Notice and the bid of Kirkland Sand and Gravel Co., in the total sum of \$20,986.00 was the lowest and best bid received for said work,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
REDMOND AS FOLLOWS

Section 1. That the Calls for Bids by the Town Clerk for the installation of the water distribution system and for waterworks materials, as above described, are hereby ratified and approved.

Section 2. That the bid of Kirkland Sand and Gravel Co., *as amended by letter of July 6, 1951 attached hereto* in the total sum of \$20,986.00 for furnishing and installing the pipe, dual pump station, pressure reducing station and storage tank base, being the lowest and best bid received, is hereby accepted.

Section 3. That the unit price bid of H. D. Fowler Co., in the total sum of \$13,029.30 for asbestos cement pipe and in the total sum of \$2,809.00 for 11 hydrants, 19 valves, and 19 valve boxes, being the lowest and best bid received, is hereby accepted.

Section 4. That the Town Clerk is hereby directed to return to the unsuccessful bidders all checks and bid bonds deposited with such unsuccessful bids. *Introduced by Carl Schultz, June 13 - 1951 Passed at first reading*
