ORDINANCE NO. 1499

ORIGINAL

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
AMENDING SECTION 7.04.060 OF THE REDMOND
MUNICIPAL CODE TO AUTHORIZE THE WAIVER OF
LICENSE FEES FOR GUIDE AND SERVICE DOGS;
CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND SETTING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Redmond City Council acknowledges that the
State legislature passed a new law requiring cities to waive
license fees for guide and service dogs when requested to do so
by the owner, and

WHEREAS, this ordinance is necessary to comply with the
new state law governing guide and service dogs, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 7.04.060 of the Redmond Municipal
Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

7.04.060 Dog and Cat Licenses and Fees -
Exemptions.

- A. The licensing provisions of this chapter shall not apply to dogs or cats in the custody of a veterinarian or animal shelter or whose owners are nonresidents temporarily within the City for a period not exceeding thirty days.
- B. When a blind person, physically disabled person or hearing impaired person requests that no fee be charged to license his or her guide or service dog, no fee shall be charged.

Section 2. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase
of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional
by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or
unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or
constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase
of this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance, being an exercise of a
power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not

subject to referendum and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of the attached approved summary.
