TOWN OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 150

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the purchase of certain real estate for essential town purposes, and specifically for a site for the erection, construction and maintainence of a 250,000 gallon water tank, and appropriate pipe and fittings installations.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND:

Section 1. The public interest, welfare, and convenience of the inhabitants of the Town of Redmond require and it is advisable that the Town of Redmond acquire certain real estate for the purpose of erecting, constructing and maintaining a 250,000 gallon water storage tank.

Section 2. The land, hereinafter described, now owned by LILLIAN WARKEN, and being sold under an executory real estate sontract to ROY b. HAIGHT and ANNA J. HAIGHT, his wife, is well suited to the purposes above set forth, the said land being situated in King County, state of Washington, and more particularly described as follows:

(The West 167 feet of the South 330 feet of the Mast one-half (1) of the Morthwest Quarter of the Mortheast Quarter of Section 1, Township 25 Morth, Mange 5 east, W.M.)

Section 3. It is hereby Ordered that upon presentation to the Town of Redmond of a good and sufficient Warranty Deed from Lilian Farren, and a Quit Claim Feed from Roy S. Haight and Anna J. Haight, his wife, together with a policy of Title Insurance which has been passed upon by the City Ittorney of the Town of Redmond, the said Town of Redmond do thereupon purchase the said described real estate as aforesaid for the amount of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00), all costs of the transfer in excess of this amount to be paid for by the said sellers.
