ORDINANCE NO. 1510

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
AMENDING SECTION 1.14.020 OF THE REDMOND
MUNICIPAL CODE TO REVISE THE NOTICE PROVISION FOR
CODE VIOLATIONS; CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY
CLAUSE; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Redmond City Council acknowledges that
code violation complainants often request anonymity and that the
City should honor such requests in order to promote effective
code enforcement, and

WHEREAS, in order to prevent the disclosure of code
violation complainants' names, Section 1.14.020 of the Redmond
Municipal Code should be amended to delete the requirement that
the notice of violation directed to the alleged violator contain
the complainant's name, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1.14.020(a) of the Redmond
Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

1.14.020 Notice of Violation.

- a. A notice of violation may be issued by the
code compliance officer to any responsible
person, firm, corporation or agent based
upon reasonable cause to believe that such
party has violated one or more of the
regulations identified in Section
1.14.090. The notice of violation shall
contain the following information:
1. A statement of the violation
observed;
 2. The location of the violation;
 3. The violation date;
 4. The title and section number of the
City regulation violated; and
 5. The date upon which compliance shall
occur.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence,
clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or
unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such
invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or

constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of the ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title.
