ORDINANCE NO. __1520

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION 2.18.010(A) OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE TO ESTABLISH AN APPOINTMENT AND TERMINATION DATE FOR MEMBERS OF THE CITY OF REDMOND'S ARTS COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, Section 2.18.010(A) of the Redmond Municipal Code establishes the City of Redmond's Arts Commission and the Commission's membership terms, and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to establish a uniform date for the appointment and termination of the Arts Commission's members, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment. Section 2.18.010(A) of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.18.010 Commission Established - - Membership.

The Redmond Arts Commission, consisting of nine members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council, is established. The term of office shall be four years and until a successor is appointed and confirmed, provided that, in order to achieve staggered terms of office, four of the initial nine members of the Commission shall serve for two years and until their successors are appointed and confirmed. All subsequent appointments shall be for four years, or for the duration of an unexpired term in case of an appointment to a vacancy. All Commission members' terms shall expire on March 31st and all successive terms shall commence on April

1st. No member shall serve more than two consecutive full terms of office.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance, being an administrative action, is not subject to referendum and shall take effect five (5) days after this ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title is published.
