Expand Definition of  
Public Place

ORDINANCE NO. 1523

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,  
AMENDING SECTION 9.04.020 OF THE REDMOND  
MUNICIPAL CODE TO EXPAND THE DEFINITION OF  
"PUBLIC PLACE"; CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE  
AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Redmond City Council finds that the  
definition of "public place" should be expanded to provide for  
more effective enforcement of the ordinance prohibiting persons  
under twenty-one years to be or remain in any public place after  
having consumed liquor, and

WHEREAS, this ordinance is in the interests of the  
public health, safety and welfare, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,  
HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 9.04.020 of the Redmond Municipal  
Code, entitled "Furnishing liquor to minors - - Possession and  
use," is hereby amended to add a new subsection (h) to read as  
follows:

- (h) For the purpose of this section, "public  
place" includes all apartment and  
condominium building parking lots, common  
areas, and any other associated areas, to  
the extent such places are reasonably  
accessible to the public, together with  
all of the locations specified in RCW  
66.44.010(23).

Section 2 Severability. If any section, sentence,  
clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or

unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3 Effective Date. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of the ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title.
