

ORDINANCE NO. 153


AN ORDINANCE prohibiting certain Minors from being in Public Places in certain hours, amending Ordinance No. 15.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Redmond as follows:-

(1) It shall be unlawful for any minor under the age of Eighteen years (18) to be abroad upon the public streets or in any other public place after the hour of 11 o'clock in the evening, unless accompanied by one or both parents or his guardian or by an adult sanctioned by the parents or guardian; and any minor who shall violate any of the provisions of this section shall be subject to arrest by any police officer without process and upon the first offense shall be taken and delivered into the custody of his or her parents or guardian and upon a second arrest may, in the discretion of the person making the arrest, be taken before the Police Justice or the Juvenile Court and shall be subject to a fine of not to exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

(2) That this Ordinance shall specifically amend Ordinance No. 15 to read as above set forth, and in addition this will serve to repeal or amend any other Ordinances in conflict herewith.
