ORDINANCE NO. 155.

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing a conveyance of certain real estate to Ed L. Nordquist and Ethel A. Nordquist, his wife.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the Town of Redmond and the Town Clerk to attest, a warranty deed, conveying to Ed L. Nordquist and Ethel A. Nordquist, his wife, the following described real property situate in the Town of Redmond, King County, state of Washington, to-wit:

South 60 feet of lot 1 (measured along the westerly line thereof), block 6, Town of Redmond, according to plat thereof recorded in volume 7 of plats, page 74, records of said county.

upon the payment by the said grantees of the sum and amount of One thousand six Hundred Dollars (\$1,600.00) therefor.
