

ORDINANCE NUMBER 156

An Ordinance amending Section 4 of Ordinance No. 90 of the Town of Redmond.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Redmond as follows:

1. That Sec. 4 of Ordinance No. 90 be amended to read as follows:

Any person owning a dog which has been impounded and who shall establish ownership of such dog within 48 hours, shall be entitled to the return of the same upon paying a license fee therefore, the cost of keeping the same at the rate of \$1.00 per day or part of a day, and of impounding the same at the rate of \$1.50. It shall be the duty of the Town Marshal or other person designated, immediately upon impounding or distraining any dog, to notify the owner of said dog if it can be determined by reasonable diligence who the owner of such dog is.
