

TOWN OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 162

AN ORDINANCE declaring a financial emergency to exist and authorizing the transfer of funds from the Current Expense Fund to the Library Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND:

Section 1. The public interest and welfare of the inhabitants of the Town of Redmond require public library facilities be maintained. Since the Redmond Public Library, a non-profit Washington corporation, and the Senior Nakomis Club can no longer contribute the full share of support as previously done, and since no funds are available in the Town of Redmond Library Fund or have been budgeted therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist.

Section 2. It is estimated that the amount of approximately ~~\$500.00~~ <sup>\$250.00</sup> will be required to meet necessary operating expenses of the said library during the year 1953, and the Town Treasurer is hereby directed to transfer that sum from the Current Expense Fund to the Library Fund on January 2, 1953.
