

TOWN OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 163

AN ORDINANCE declaring a financial emergency to exist and authorizing the transfer of funds from the Current Expense Fund to the Street Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND:

Section 1. Certain streets in the Town of Redmond have become so dangerous and hazardous to persons and property, due to the inability of the Town to finance the purchase of adequate equipment for proper maintenance of said streets, same not being provided for in the Town budget and the Street Fund being depleted, that an emergency is hereby declared to exist.

Section 2. It is estimated that the amount of \$1,200.00 will be required for the down payment for the purchase of a suitable road grader, and the Town Treasurer is hereby directed to transfer that sum from the Current Expense Fund to the Street Fund as of the second day of January, 1953.
