

ORDINANCE No 173

and/or wrecking YARDS

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING JUNK YARDS, WITHIN THE TOWNE OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AS A PUBLIC NUISANCE, AND PROVIDING FOR THE ABATEMENT THEREOF AND PROVIDING A PENALTY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY The Town Council of the Town of Redmond Washington:

SECTION 1:

AND/OR WRECKING YARDS

That all junk yards within the Town of Redmond, Washington are a public nuisance because they accumulate rubbish, scrap-iron, junk-pipe, old, worn-out wrecked and dismantled automobiles and parts and other junk and refuse, and, as a consequence, they are unkept, unclean, unsightly, odorous, filthy and an eyesore, serving to detract from the appearance and character of and to discredit and disparage the Town of Redmond to depreciate property values and to vex, annoy and threaten the security and welfare of the inhabitants of said town.

SECTION 2:

It is therefore ^{ORDAINED} ordered that the owners of all junk yards now located within the Town of Redmond, Washington shall within thirty days of the adoption of this ordinance discontinue the operation of said junk yard and shall have removed all such accumulated parts and debris from within the Town limits of the Town of Redmond.

SECTION 3:

It is hereby ^{ORDAINED} ordered that no person shall in the future establish, own or operate a junk yard within the Town limits of the Town of Redmond, Washington.

SECTION 4:

Any person violating the provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not exceeding three hundred dollars or committed to jail to serve out such fine and costs at the rate of three dollars per day.
