

TOWN OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,

ORDINANCE NO. 174

AN ORDINANCE fixing the salaries of the Clerk,
the waterworks and street foreman, the Town Hall janitor
and the marshal, and of the police judge of the Town of Redmond.

Be it ordained by the TOWN COUNCIL of the TOWN OF REDMOND,
AS FOLLOWS:

Sec.1 That the salary of the Clerk shall be \$90.00 per month,

Sec.2 That the salary of the water and street foreman shall be
\$325.00 per month.

Sec 3 That the salary of the Town Hall janitor shall be \$50.00
per month.

Sec. 4 That the salary of the marshal shall be \$325.00 per
month.

Sec.5 That the above salary increases be retroactive to
January 1st. 1954.

Sec.6 That the salary of the police Judge shall be \$50.00
per month, beginning July 1st, 1954.

All ordinances heretofore passed, that are in conflict
herewith are hereby repealed.
