AN ORDINANCE LICENSING DANCE HALLS AND PLACES WHERE DANCING IS PERMITTED, FIXING THE LICENSE FEE, EXCLUDING CERTAIN MINORS THERE-FROM AND FIXING THE TIME OF CLOSING.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF REDMOND:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person, organization, firm or corporation to operate a dance hall or to permit dancing in connection with the regular operation of a business without first having secured a license so to do. The fee for such license or licenses shall be as follows: One Dollar (\$1.00) for each time that a dance is held in cases where the dance is for one night only; where dancing is permitted on a continuous basis in connection with the operating of a business the license fee shall be Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) per month. Such licenses shall be issued by the Town Clerk upon receipt of the fees as hereinabove set forth. No dance shall continue later than 1:00 O'clock A.M.

Section 2: All minors under the age of 16 years shall not be allowed in dance halls unless accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. Any person, firm, organization or corporation operating a dance for any public benefit shall receive a dance license free of charge by applying to the Town Clerk for same.

Section 3: Each and every dance operated in the Town of Redmond shall be policed to the satisfaction of the Town authorities, without cost to the Town, by the party or parties operating such dance.

Section 4: Ordinance No. 87, together with any and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section 5: Any person, organization, firm or corporation failing to comply with the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or imprisoned in the Town Jail for not more than thirty (30) days, or both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 6: This ordinance shall be in effect commencing January 1, 1956.
