

ORDINANCE NO. 182

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE TOWN OF REDMOND AND INCORPORATING THE SAME WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS THEREOF.

1 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND  
AS FOLLOWS:

2 WHEREAS, there was heretofore and timely filed with the Town  
3 Clerk of the Town of Redmond a petition for annexation addressed  
4 to the Mayor and Council of the Town of Redmond, and signed by the  
5 owners of more than 75 per cent in value, according to the  
6 assessed valuation for general taxation of property, of the here-  
inafter described area and territory seeking to incorporate the  
said area within the corporate limits of the Town of Redmond, and  
make the same part of the said Town; and

7 WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Washington has pro-  
8 vided that on the filing of such a petition of annexation, with  
9 the requisite number of signatures of bona fide residents and  
property owners thereof, the Council may by Ordinance, and after  
due hearing, incorporate such territory within the Town, and

10 WHEREAS, thereafter and on the 14th day of March, 1956, the  
11 Council by appropriate action adopted a resolution setting forth  
12 the above recited facts, and fixed Wednesday, the 28th day of  
13 March, 1956, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M., and the Council  
hearing upon the petition for annexation of the following described  
area; and

14 WHEREAS, notice of such hearing was published in the Sammam-  
15 ish Valley News, a newspaper of general circulation in the Town  
16 of Redmond, and was posted in three public places within the  
hereinafter described area and territory proposed to be annexed,  
setting forth the time and place of such hearing; and

17 WHEREAS, on this 28th day of March, 1956, at the hour of  
18 8:00 o'clock, P.M., the said hearing was held and the Council  
considered the said petition, and

19 WHEREAS, the Council considers that the best interests of the  
20 Town of Redmond, and of the hereinafter described area, would be  
served by annexing the same to the Town of Redmond; now, therefore,

21 IT IS ORDAINED AND ORDERED, that the following described  
22 territory consisting of the following described real estate sit-  
23 uated in the County of King and State of Washington, and contig-  
uous to the Town of Redmond, be and the same is hereby annexed  
to and incorporated into the Town of Redmond, to-wit:

24 That portion of the west half of the northeast  
25 quarter of Section 11, Township 25 North, Range 5 East,  
26 W.M. lying northerly of W. W. Easter Road, EXCEPT the  
Sammamish River, now Drainage District No. 3, and  
27 EXCEPT the Northern Pacific Railway right-of-way,  
EXCEPT State Road No. 2D, and

28 EXCEPT that portion lying within the highway along  
29 the north line of said subdivision and EXCEPT that  
30 triangular portion lying southerly of State Road No. 2D  
31 and northeasterly of the Northern Pacific Railway  
right-of-way.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED: That this Ordinance shall take  
effect from and after its passage by the Council and approved by


1 the Mayor, and after its legal publication as required by law,
