ORDINANCE NO. 183

AN ORDINANCE accepting the bid of General Electric Supply Co. for the furnishing of street lighting equipment.

WHEREAS, notice of the call for bids for the furnishing of certain street lighting equipment, as provided in Ordinance No. 179, was duly posted and published in the manner provided by law; and

WHEREAS, bids submitted by General Electric Supply Co., Graybar Electric Company, and Line Material Company were received and were publicly opened and read at a meeting of the Town Council held on March 28, 1956, at 8:00 o'clock p.m. in accordance with the notice of call for bids; and

WHEREAS, John B. Dodds, engineer for the Town on the street lighting project, has submitted a bid tabulation showing the bid of General Electric Supply Co. to be the lowest and best bid received, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, that the bid of General Electric Supply Co. for the furnishing of street lighting equipment, as set forth in the Proposal submitted by said bidder, for a total bid price of \$8,512.00, is hereby accepted and the proper Town officers are hereby authorized and directed to purchase said street lighting equipment from General Electric Supply Co. in accordance with the Proposal as submitted by said company.
