ORDINANCE NO. 184.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 182 IN REGARD TO THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE TOWN OF REDMOND.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND, AS FOLLOWS:

That the legal description of real property which was annexed to the Town of Redmond, Washington by virtue of Ordinance 182 of the said Town of Redmond be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

In King County, State of Washington:

That portion of the west one-half of the northeast quarter of Section 11, Township 25 north, range 5 east, W.M., lying northwesterly of W. W. Easter Road, easterly of the Sammamish River, now King County Drainage District No. 3, southerly of Kirkland-Redmond Shortline Road, also known as County Road No. 1883, and southwesterly of the Northern Pacific Railroad right-of-way.

PASSED by the Council and Approved by the Mayor on the 25th day of April, 1956.
