ORDINANCE NO.

AN OMDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANDEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE TOWN OF REDMOND AND INCORPORATING THE SAME WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, there was heretofore and timely filed with the Town Clerk of the Town of Redmond a petition for annexation addressed to the Mayor and Council of the Town of Redmond, and signed by the owners of more than 75 per cent in value, according to the assessed valuation for general taxation of property, of the here-inafter described area and territory seeking to incorporate the said area within the corporate limits of the Town of Redmond, and make the same part of the said own; and

WHEREAS, thereafter and on the 25th day of April, 1956, the Council by appropriate action adopted a resolution setting forth the above recited facts, and fixed Wednesday, the 23rd day of May, 1956, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M., and the Council Chambers in the Town of Redmond, as the time and place for a public than the Town of Town of the following described hearing upon the petition for annexation of the following described area; and

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing was published in the Sammam-ish Valley News, a newspaper of general circulation in the Town of Redmond, and was posted in three public places within the hereinafter described area and territory proposed to be annexed, setting forth the time and place of such hearing; and

WHEREAS, on this 23rd day of May, 1956, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock, P.M., the said hearing was held and the Council considered the said petition, and

WPEREAS, the Council considers that the best interests of the Town of Redmond, and of the hereinafter described area, would be served by annexing the same to the Town of Redmond; now, therefore,

IN IS OMDAINED AND ORDERAD, that the following described territory consisting of the following described real estate situated in the County of Ling and State of Washington, and contiguous to the Town of Redmond, be and the same is hereby annexed to and incorporated into the Town of Redmond, to-wit:

inat portion of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 11, fownship 25 North, Range 5 East, M.M., in king County, sashington, lying southeasterly of the northwisterly boundary of State Aid Road No. 56, also known as W. W. Easter head, lying northeasterly of the northeasterly margin of Secondary State Highway No. 2-D, also known as lest Lake lammamish Boulevard,

CLPT the triangular portion thereof lying southeasterly of said State Aid Road Mo. 56 and northeasterly of the northerly margin of said King County Drainage District No. 3, and

EXCEPT the south 150 feet of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of said Lection 11.

EL IT FURTHER ORDAINED: That this Ordinance shall take ffect from and after its passage by the Council and approved by the Mayor, and after its legal publication as required by law, and shall thereafter be in full force and effect.
