Ordinance No. 193

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF REDIKIND, WASHINGTON, SUPPLEMENTING EXISTING BUILDING CODES AND ORDIVANCES AND REQUIRING THAT IN
ADDITION TO USUAL PERMITS AND REQUIREDENTS, WHENEVER A BUILDING
OR STRUCTUME IS NOVED OR PROPOSED TO BE MOVED, INTO OR WITHIN THE
TOWN OF REDI OND AND REQUIRING REPAIR, REBUILDING, ALTERATION OR
ADDITION, THE APPLICANT SMALL FILE A PERFORMANCE BOND, CONDITIONED
UPON BRINGING THE BUILDING OR STRUCTURE UP TO BUILDING CODE
STANDARDS, AND FURTHER CO DITIONED UPON THE COMPLETION OF THE
NECESSARY WORK WITHIN SIX FORTHER FROM THE DATE OF PERMIT, OR POST
A CASH DEPOSIT IN LIEU THEREOF AND PROVIDING FOR THE FORFEITURE
OR RETURN THEREOF, AND REQUIRING THE SUBMISSION OF BLUEPRINTS OR
ARCHITECTS DRAWINGS, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS

The Town Council of the Town of Redmond + ERF BY ORDAINS as follows

SECTION 1. Supplementing any requirements of the Building Code and Ordinances of the Town of Redmond and, in addition thereto, whenever any owner or other party desires to move any building or structure into or within the Town of Redmond which requires repair, rebuilding, alterations or additions in order to comply with the standards and requirements of the Town of Redmond, that in addition to the usual requirements of the Building Code and applicable ordinances, such party shall also file with the Clerk of the Town of Redmond a performance bond executed by a surety company acceptable to the Town Council in the amount of the estimated costs of such removal or moving, alterations, repairs, changes, additions or rebuilding as estimated by the Town Engineer or such other designated official of the Town of Redmond as may be determined by the Town Council. Such performance bond shall be conditioned upon the owner, resident or other party securing a permit for such work, faithfully bringing the exterior of the building or structure so moved, and/or altered, rebuilt or repaired, up to all standards as required by the Building Code and ordinances of the Town of Redmond and shall further be conditioned upon the owner or applicant completing such exterior work and complying (as to the exterior) with the Building Code and ordinances of the Town of Redmond within six months from the date such permit is granted. In lieu of such performance bond, such party may place with a depository designated by the Town Council an amount equal to low of the estimated total cost of all repairs, rebuilding, alterations and additions required by the property. Funds so deposited shall be forfeited to the Town of Redmond within six months of the date of the permit herein referred to. If not so forfeited, said funds shall be returned to the party so depositing them.

SECTION 2. In addition to the usual requirements for issuance of a permit, or permits, for moving, repairing, altering or remodeling any building within the Town of Redmond, the amplicant shall furnish a satisfactory blueprint or an Architect's drawing of the finished structure.

SECTION 3: The requirements of the ordinance shall be in addition to all existing requirements of the Building Code and redinances of the Town of Redmond.

SECTION 4 The permit required by this ordinance shall be assued by the Town Engineer or other designated official of the town of Redmond as may be determined by the Town Council.

Any person, firm or corporation who violates, disobeys, omits, neglects or refuses to comply with, or who resists the enforcement of any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined in any sum of not more than \$100.00 or imprisoned in the city Jail for a term of not to exceed 30 days or both for each offense. Each day that a violation is permitted to continue to exist shall constitute a separate offense. In addition to the foregoing penalties, compliance with the provisions of this ordinance may be compelled by any available legal remedy, and the use of premise violating this ordinance may be enjoined. SECTION 6. This ordinance may become effective immediately PASSED by the Town Council of the Town of Redmond, Washington at a regular meeting held this 25th day of April, 1956.
