

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION AND CONNECTION OF NEW SERVICES TO THE TOWN OF REDMOND WATER SYSTEM AND PROVIDING FOR COSTS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 2: That all persons desiring water service connection with the facilities of the Town water system are required to make application for such connection and installation with the Town Clerk of said Town, who shall then have the duty of referring said application to the Water Superintendent of the Town of Redmond; that all such installations or connections made to the Town water system shall be made by or under the direction of the said Water Superintendent.

Section 3: That all water ^{meters} materials furnished by the Town of Redmond in such installations or connections shall be and remain the property of the Town of Redmond.

Section 4: That the Town Council of the Town of Redmond upon the recommendation and advice of the Water Superintendent shall set such prices to be charged applicants for each such installation or connection as shall be determined by the Council, taking into account the size and type of connection. The said price list for installations and connections shall be listed in the office of the Town Clerk, available to the general public and may be changed no more often than once each year.

PASSED by the Town Council of Redmond, Washington and approved by the Mayor on the 25th day of July, 1956.
