

ORDINANCE NUMBER 212

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING THE REDMOND WATERSHED IN KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, TO THE TOWN OF REDMOND

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Redmond, State of Washington, as follows:

WHEREAS, at a joint meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Redmond with its planning commission on the 9th day of January, 1958, it was recommended by the Planning Commission that the Town Council annex the Redmond Watershed as described hereinafter for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Redmond having decided that it will be for the benefit of the Town and for the general benefit of the watershed to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Redmond is the sole owner of the property described hereinafter,

IT IS ORDAINED AND ORDERED that the following described property be and is hereby annexed to the Town of Redmond:

All of Section 28, Twp. 26 N., Range 6 E. W. N.; and the northwest quarter of Sec. 33, Twp. 26 N., Range 6 E. W. N.; and that portion of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Sec. 33, Twp. 26 N., Range 6 E. W. N. lying north of the centerline of County Road, Survey number 1430, also known as the Novelty Road, all in King County, Washington.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED AND ORDERED that the above-described real property shall become a part of the Town of Redmond on the 10th day of January, 1958, and become subject to all of its laws and ordinances therein and thereafter enforced.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED AND ORDERED that certified copies of this ordinance be filed with the Board of County Commissioners, King County, Washington.

PASSED by the Town Council of the Town of Redmond and approved by the Mayor on the 10th day of January, 1958.
