

ORDINANCE NUMBER 220

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN REAL ESTATE IN KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, TO THE TOWN OF REDMOND

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Redmond, State of Washington, as follows:

WHEREAS, a written petition has been presented to the Town Council of the Town of Redmond, requesting annexation of the real property described below; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Redmond, Washington, has examined the said petition and certified that the petition was signed by the owners of not less than seventy-five percent in value according to the assessed valuation for general taxation of the property described therein, and in all other respects has met the requirements of the laws of the State of Washington concerning annexation by Towns; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council having set the 26th day of February, 1958, as the date for public hearing concerning the said petition, and caused notice of the said hearing to be published and posted in accordance with the law, and said hearing having been held; and

IT APPEARING to the Town Council of the Town of Redmond that the proposed annexation of the property described hereinafter will be for the benefit of the Town of Redmond and for the general benefit of the area to be annexed,

IT IS ORDAINED AND ORDERED that the following described real property be and is hereby annexed to the Town of Redmond:

That portion of the west half of Government Lot 5, Section 6, Township 25 north, Range 6 E. W. M., lying southeasterly of the southeasterly margin of the Redmond-Bear Creek Road.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED AND ORDERED that the above described real property shall become a part of the Town of Redmond on the 26th day of February, 1958, and become subject to all of its laws and ordinances therein and thereafter enacted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED AND ORDERED that certified copies of this ordinance be filed with the Board of County Commissioners, King County, Washington.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED AND ORDERED that the Town Clerk obtain and file in duplicate with the State Census Board the required certificate determining the population of the annexed territory.


