

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE REPAIRING, IMPROVING,  
OR OTHERWISE ALTERING OF THE PUBLIC STREETS OF  
THE TOWN OF REDMOND.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. PERMIT REQUIRED. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to commence to repair, improve, alter or otherwise perform any street maintenance or work upon the public streets and highway rights of way within the Town of Redmond without first having obtained a permit from the Street Superintendent authorizing said work.

Section 2. APPLICATION FOR PERMIT. Any person, firm or corporation required to obtain a permit for work in a public street or right of way shall file an application therefore with the Street Superintendent. The application shall be in writing and upon forms provided by the Town of Redmond and shall contain information showing the type of construction, the length, the exact location, the purposes and other information which may be required by the Street Superintendent concerning the proposed street opening or work in the public right of way. The provisions of this section shall apply to public utilities or quasi municipal corporations qualified for and seeking permits for street openings or work in the public streets and rights of way of the Town of Redmond.

Section 3. REFUSAL OF APPLICATION. Wherever work in the public streets or rights of way within the Town of Redmond will create an exceptional traffic hazard or will unreasonably restrict the use of town streets, will create an impediment to the free movement of vehicles upon the afore mentioned streets, or an uneconomic distribution of parking space at the curb of afore mentioned streets, or a hazard to the travel or safety of pedestrians thereon, the town Street Superintendent, at his discretion, may refuse any application made under the terms of this ordinance.

Section 4. SAFETY REQUIREMENTS. The safety requirements of the Town of Redmond and of the State of Washington as applicable to any work for which a permit is required hereunder shall be observed.

Section 5. STREET RESTORATION. The Town of Redmond Street Superintendent is hereby authorized to require a bond or deposit in any permittee under this ordinance in order to guarantee the restoration of the street or right of way back to its original condition.

Section 6. PERMIT FEES. Permits required hereunder specifying the authorized work, shall be issued by the town Street Superintendent upon proper application therefore and upon payment of the fees required, to wit: (a) A basic fee of one dollar (\$1.00) plus (b) An amount to be determined by the town Street Superintendent based on a maximum amount of 5% of the estimated cost of construction, this fee shall be based on the estimated cost of inspection as determined by the Street Superintendent. (c) In the event that reinspection is necessary, the fee shall be charged according to the cost of reinspection to the Town of Redmond.

Section 7. PENALTY. Any person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment in the Town jail for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
