ORDINANCE NO. 248

AN ORDINANCE of the Town of Redmond amending Ordinance No. 207, fixing rates and charges for water service and sewerage service; repealing Ordinance No. 225; and repealing all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND:

Section 1 Section 2 of Ordinance No. 207 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2 For the purpose of fixing rates and charges for the furnishing of water by the Town of Redmond, the Town Council hereby establishes the following metered rates based upon water consumption:

INSIDE TOWN

First 500 cubic feet, or any part thereof: \$3.00 per month as a minimum; Next 3000 cubic feet: \$0.30 per 100 cubic feet; Next 3500 cubic feet: \$0.25 per 100 cubic feet; Next 8000 cubic feet: \$0.10 per 100 cubic feet; All over 15,000 cubic feet: \$0.05 per 100 cubic feet.

OUTSIDE TOWN

Inside Town rates plus 25% thereof shall apply.

In addition to the above, a hydrant rental rate of fifty cents per hydrant per month is hereby established.

Section 2 Section 3 of Ordinance No. 207 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3 For the furnishing of service to the users of the Town's sanitary sewerage system, the Town Council hereby establishes the following flat rates: per month for the classification of user indicated, to wit:

<u>Classification of User</u>	<u>Monthly Rate</u>
1. Residence	- \$3.00 per living unit
2. Churches	- \$3.00 each
3. Motels, hotels, trailer units and rooming houses	- \$1.75 per living unit
4. Nursing Homes	- \$1.10 per patient
5. Taverns and Cafes	- \$12.00 each
6. Garages and Service Stations	- \$7.00 each
7. Supermarkets	- \$12.00 each
8. Creameries	- \$12.00 each

Classification of Users

Monthly Rate

- 9. Schools - \$0.25 per each student, teacher, administrative and shop personnel, for the nine school months of each year, and for the remaining three months of the year the residential rate shall apply. The student population shall be based upon average daily attendance during the month preceding billing date as the same is reported to the State of Washington, Department of Education.
- 10. Dry Cleaning Plants - \$7.00 each
- 11. Feed Mills - \$8.50 each
- 12. Laundromats and Launderettes - \$8.50 minimum for the first ten machines, plus \$0.50 for each additional machine
- 13. All others not classified - \$4.50 each *unless otherwise set by Council action*

PUBLIC INFORMATION

The rate for the Redmond Nike Control Area and Battalion Headquarters shall be in accordance with the Utility Service Contract No. DA-45-108-ENG-4094 between the Town and the United States of America, Department of the Army.

In the event that any user of the Town's sanitary sewerage system, by the nature of his business, may fall within two or more of the above classifications, the rate for such user shall be the highest rate established for any such classification.

Section 3 Ordinance No. 225 and all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4 This ordinance shall take effect on the 1st day of January, 1961.
