

TOWN of REDMOND

Ordinance No. 249

AN ORDINANCE regulating the operation of pool rooms, billiard rooms, and card rooms within the Town of Redmond; providing for the licensing thereof and fixing license fees; providing penalties for violations; and repealing Ordinances 32 and 84 and all ordinances or part thereof in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to open, carry on, maintain, or conduct any pool room, billiard room, or card room or room for the playing of any other games within the Town of Redmond without first having obtained and being the holder of a valid and subsisting license so to do, to be known as a "Pool and Card Room License." The fee for any such Pool and Card Room License shall be the sum of \$500.00 per year, payable semi-annually in advance on January 1 and July 1 of the applicable calendar year. The entire license fee shall be payable for the applicable year regardless of when the operation of said activity was commenced and the same shall not be pro-rated for any part of the year.

Sec. 2. Application for any such license shall be made in writing to the Town Council at a regular meeting thereof and the same shall not be acted upon at the meeting at which originally presented, but shall go over to the next meeting of the Council and notice of such application shall be given by posting three copies thereof in public places within the Town of Redmond so that any persons interested may appear before the Council to object to the granting of any such license.

Sec. 3. Any such pool room, billiard room and card room shall at all times be

conducted in an orderly manner and minors shall not be allowed therein; and in the event of the failure of any proprietor thereof to conduct the same in an orderly manner as herein provided for, the Council may in its discretion cancel such license, in which event the unearned portion of the license fee shall be forfeited to the Town of Redmond.

Sec. 4. The license granted under this ordinance shall be personal to the applicant and the same shall not be transferable nor shall the license fees paid hereunder be refundable except by action of the Town Council.

Sec. 5. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in an amount not exceeding \$100.00, or by imprisonment in jail not exceeding 30 days.

Sec. 6. Ordinances 32 and 84 and all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Sec. 7. This Ordinance shall be in full force and shall take effect on the 1st day of January, 1961.
