

AN ORDINANCE regulating the operation of cabaret dance within the town of Redmond; providing for the licensing thereof and fixing license fees; providing penalties for violation; and repealing Ordinance No. 177 and all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND:

Section 1. As used in this ordinance the term "cabaret dance" shall be construed to mean a dance held or permitted in connection with a business where intoxicating liquors are sold or consumed.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to operate or conduct a cabaret dance within the Town of Redmond without first having obtained and being the holder of a valid and subsisting license so to do. To be known as a "Cabaret Dance License". The fee for any such Cabaret Dance License shall be as follows:

For a single dance, the sum of \$25.00; For an annual license, the sum of \$500.00 per year, payable semi-annually in advance on January 1 and July 1 of the applicable calendar year. The entire license fee shall be payable for the applicable year, regardless of when the application for license is made, and the same shall not be pro-rated for any part of the year except by action of the Town Council.

No license to conduct a cabaret dance shall be granted unless the applicant therefor be of good moral character.

Section 3. Application for any such license shall be made in writing to the Town Council at a regular meeting thereof and shall set forth the name and place of residence of the applicant, the address and description of the premises to be licensed, the time and number of dances to be held, and such other information as the Council may require. The Council may in its discretion refuse to grant a license for a cabaret dance to be conducted at such a time or place as will in their judgment interfere with the comfort and well-being of the community.

Section 4. Each and every cabaret dance licensed hereunder shall at all times be conducted in an orderly manner, shall be policed to the satisfaction of the Town authorities, without cost to the Town, by the licensee and minors shall not be allowed therein. No dance shall continue later than 2:00 A.M.

Section 5. The license granted under this ordinance shall be personal to the applicant and the same shall not be transferable nor shall the license fees paid hereunder be refundable except by action of the Town Council. Each license shall at all times be conspicuously displayed. Upon revocation of a license for a violation of this ordinance, the unearned portion of the license fee shall be forfeited to the Town of Redmond.

Section 6. This ordinance shall not apply to dances conducted for a public benefit or by a non-profit organization.

Section 7. Ordinance No. 177 and all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 253

Section 8. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in an amount not exceeding \$100.00, or by imprisonment in jail not exceeding 30 days.

Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
