

AN ORDINANCE of the Town of Redmond, Washington, amending Ordinance No. 178; fixing license fees for machines used for playing games of skill for commercial purposes; and repealing Ordinance No. 247.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND:

Section 1. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 178 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 5. Each license shall be issued for a period of one month. The monthly license fee for each machine or device shall be as follows:

By the owner of the machine or device, \$15.00 per month per machine or device, with a minimum of \$105.00 per month for any and all machines or devices up to and including 7 with an additional fee of \$15.00 per month for each additional machine or device over said minimum:

By the owner of the business establishment in which the machine or device is placed for operation, the fee shall be \$12.50 per month per machine or device.

No license shall be transferred from one machine or device to the other, and no machine or device which is licensed shall be transferred from one location to another except with the consent of the Town Council.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 247, effective January 1, 1961, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect on the 8th day of March, 1961.

PASSED by the Council of the Town of Redmond at a regular meeting thereof and APPROVED by the Mayor this 8th day of March, 1961.
