ORDINANCE NO. 261

AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance No. 249, relating to the regulation of pool rooms, billiard rooms, and card rooms; providing for the licensing thereof and fixing license fees.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 249, approved December 14, 1960, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to open, carry on, maintain, or conduct any pool room, billiard room, or card room or room for the playing of any other games within the City of Redmond without first having obtained and being the holder of a valid and subsisting license so to do, to be known as a "Pool and Card Room License." The fee for any such Pool and Card Room License shall be the sum of \$250.00, payable in advance, for a six (6) month period of time commencing on January 1 and July 1 of the applicable calendar year. The entire license fee shall be payable for the applicable six-month period regardless of when the operation of said activity was commenced and the same shall not be pro-rated for any part of the six-month period.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond at a regular meeting thereof and APPROVED by the Mayor this 9th day of August, 1961.
