

ORDINANCE NO. 262

AN ORDINANCE of the City of Redmond prohibiting the throwing, placing or depositing or maintaining rubbish, debris, litter or other discarded matter upon the public highways, streets, alleys and public grounds within the City of Redmond; and providing penalties for violations.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 - It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to throw, place, deposit, keep or maintain any rubbish, debris, litter, or discarded matter of any nature or description upon or along any public highway, street, alley or public grounds within the City of Redmond, except that rubbish, debris or other matter placed in suitable containers, boxed or packaged to meet the specifications of licensed garbage disposal company or companies operating within the City of Redmond, near or along a public way may be so deposited in a marked litter container provided for such purpose, or may be so deposited by the occupant of the premises immediately adjacent thereto, provided, however, that such may not be so placed by such occupant for a period exceeding twenty-four (24) hours.

Section 2 - It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to operate, drive or move any vehicle upon a public highway, street or alley of the City of Redmond unless it is so constructed or loaded as to prevent any of its load from dropping, sifting, leaking or otherwise escaping therefrom, provided, that sand may be dropped for the purpose of securing traction, or water or other substance may be sprinkled or used upon a roadway in the cleaning, maintaining or servicing of such roadway by the public authority having jurisdiction.

Any person operating a vehicle from which glass or objects have fallen or escaped, which would constitute an obstruction or hazard to a vehicle or otherwise endanger travel upon such public way shall immediately cause the public way to be cleaned of all such glass or objects.

Section 3 - Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in an amount not exceeding \$ 100.00, or by imprisonment in jail not exceeding 30 days.

Section 4 - This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, approval and publication in the manner required by law.
