

ORDINANCE NO. 264

AN ORDINANCE, declaring an emergency in the Current Expense Fund and providing for an expenditure in excess of the estimated expenditures in said fund, and providing for the issuance of emergency warrants.

WHEREAS, the exterior of the City Hall is badly deteriorated and is in need of repair and restoration in order to prevent further and costly damage to the building by the action of the elements; and

WHEREAS, it is imperative that this condition be corrected immediately to prevent further damage and the City Council finds that an emergency therefor exists requiring the expenditure of funds in the estimated amount of \$ 7500.00, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 That an emergency is hereby declared to exist which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time the estimates were made, requiring an expenditure of money not provided for in said estimates, and the expenditure of \$ 7500.00 is hereby authorized out of the Current Expense Fund for the repair and restoration of the exterior of the City Hall of Redmond, Washington in order to provide for said emergency.

Section 2 Said emergency expenditure shall be paid by the issuance of emergency warrants to be paid from any moneys on hand in the city treasury in the City Hall Maintenance of the Current Expense Fund, or if there be insufficient money on hand in such fund, such warrants shall be registered and shall bear interest at the rate of 5 1/2% per annum until called for and paid.

Section 3 This Ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public property of the City of Redmond and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
