

ORDINANCE NO. 265

AN ORDINANCE of the City of Redmond, Washington, adopting the budget and levying the taxes for the City of Redmond for the year 1962.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 That the Budget for the City of Redmond, for the year 1962 be and the same hereby is adopted and the appropriation totals for each of the following classes is established as follows:

1. Salaries and Wages -	\$ 54,232.00
2. Maintenance and Operation -	\$ 75,901.00
3. Capital Outlay -	\$ 25,920.00
4. Interest & Debt Redemption -	\$ 39,248.00
5. Expenditures proposed to be made from bond or warrant issues not yet authorized -	None
Total Appropriation -	<u>\$195,301.00</u>

Section 2 Be it further ordained that the tax levy for the year 1962 is hereby fixed as follows:

Redmond Limits 1 - 22.0 mills
Redmond Limits 2 - 21.1 mills
Redmond Limits 3 - 18.9 mills

Section 3 Copies of the detailed and itemized budget adopted for the year 1962 shall be kept on file at the office of the City Clerk and shall be available for inspection.

Section 4 This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
