

ORDINANCE NO. 272

AN ORDINANCE, classifying and designating city streets within the City of Redmond as Major Arterials, Secondary Arterials and Access Streets.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 - The city streets within the corporate limits of the City of Redmond are hereby classified and designated as Major Arterials, Secondary Arterials and Access Streets as defined by Chapter 164, Laws of 1949 (R.C.W. 35.78), as described, marked and indicated in that certain map prepared by the City Engineer, entitled "Comprehensive Road Program, Major Arterials, Secondary Arterials and Access Streets", attached hereto and by this reference made a part of this Ordinance as though fully set out herein.

Section 2 - The City Clerk shall certify two copies of this Ordinance together with accompanying map and file the same with the Director of Highways, State of Washington.

Section 3 - This Ordinance shall take effect five days after its publication.
