

ORDINANCE NO. 273

AN ORDINANCE, relating to sewerage and drainage from public and private premises and the collection and disposal thereof; regulating the discharge wastes in public sewers; and amending Ordinance No. 208 by adding a new section thereto.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 - Ordinance No. 208, effective December 15, 1957, is hereby amended by the addition of a new section thereto, as follows:

Section 12.5 - "Every commercial and institutional ^{ESTABLISHMENT} ~~food~~ ^{FOOD} processing plant shall be so equipped as to prevent discharge of animal or vegetable parts of such size as can be retained on a standard 20 mesh screen having openings measuring approximately 0.84 millimeters. Any discharge of parts large enough to be retained on such a screen, whether intentional or unintentional, shall be deemed a violation of this Ordinance. The owners and/or operators of such food processing establishments shall make provision at their own expense for the elimination of all such screenings other than by discharge of the same into a public sewer."

Section 2 - This ordinance shall take effect five days after its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond at a regular meeting thereof and APPROVED by the Mayor this 13TH day of December, 1961.
