

ORDINANCE NO. 282

AN ORDINANCE, relating to water service and sewer service and amending Section 7 of Ordinance No. 207.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 - Section 7 of Ordinance No. 207, passed December 11, 1957, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 7 - Each separate residence, multiple housing structure, and business building using water from the city water system shall have a separate direct connection with the water main and a separate shutoff, and a separate connection charge will be made for each such connection. Each separate residence, multiple housing structure and business building using the city system of sewerage shall have a separate direct connection with the sewerage system, and a separate connection charge will be made for each such connection. Applications for connection to the city system of sewerage shall be made to the Water and Sewer Superintendent on a printed form furnished for that purpose, and a permit fee of \$1.00 shall be paid by each applicant. A connection charge of \$50.00 shall be paid for each connection to the city system of sewerage and, in addition, an inspection fee of \$10.00 shall be paid for each such installation, provided, however, that for temporary installations (not to exceed six months period of time) the City Council may, in its discretion, modify and adjust such connection charge and inspection fee.


Section 2 - This Ordinance shall take effect five days after the passage, approval, and publication in the manner required by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof and APPROVED by the Mayor this 28th day of March, 1962.


