

ORDINANCE NO. 287

AN ORDINANCE, declaring an emergency in the Current Expense Fund (Police Department) under the general classes Salaries and Wages, Maintenance and operation, and Capital Outlay and providing for an expenditure in excess of the estimated expenditures in said fund and classes; providing for the issuance of emergency warrants; and establishing a salary for an additional class of police patrolman.

WHEREAS, recent annexations have materially extended the City's boundaries and have increased the size of the City, taxing the ability of the City to provide proper police protection with its present equipment and police force; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that an emergency therefore exists in the ability of the City to provide proper police protection and that such condition can be alleviated by the expenditure of funds in the estimated amount of \$6,500.00 for the purchase of a police car and to employ additional help, Now, Therefore.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 - That an emergency is hereby declared to exist which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time the estimates were made, requiring an expenditure of \$6,500.00 in funds not provided for in said estimates, and the expenditure of \$6,500.00 is hereby authorized out of the Current Expense Fund (Police Department) under the general classes Salaries and Wages, Maintenance and Operations, and Capital Outlay in order to provide for said emergency as follows:

Section 2 - Said emergency expenditure shall be paid by the issuance of emergency warrants to be paid from any moneys on hand in the City Treasury in the Current Expense Fund not otherwise appropriated, or if there be insufficient money on hand in such fund, such warrants shall be registered and shall bear interest at the rate of 5% per annum until called for and paid.

Section 3 - There is hereby established in the Police Department, under the general class Salaries and Wages in the Current Expense Fund, two grades of Patrolman. The existing Patrolman shall be known as "Patrolman, Grade 1" and the salary for such position shall be \$4,980.00 annually as set in Ordinance No. 268 for Patrolman. The additional position of "Patrolman, Grade 2" is hereby established by this Ordinance and the salary for such position shall be the sum of \$4,800.00 annually.

Section 4 - The publication of a copy of this Ordinance in accordance with RCW 35.33.090 prior to its adoption shall constitute publication of the Ordinance under the requirements of RCW 35.24.220. provided no changes have been made in the proposed Ordinance upon its adoption.

Section 5 - This Ordinance shall take effect on June 12, 1962
