

ORDINANCE NO. 292

AN ORDINANCE, providing for an expenditure in excess of the estimated expenditures in the Street Department Fund under the general class Maintenance and Operation based upon unanticipated revenues in said fund and class.

WHEREAS, funds have been received in the Street Department Fund under the general class Maintenance and Operation in excess of the anticipated revenues to said fund and class at the time the annual estimates were made and the City Council finds it appropriate and in the public interest that said unanticipated revenues be expended for public maintenance and improvement of streets, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 - That the sum of \$1,500.00, received by the City of Redmond for street improvement, which sum is in excess of the anticipated revenues for the Street Department Fund under the general class Maintenance and Operation, is hereby budgeted and appropriated for expenditures for street improvement and maintenance under the item Materials and Supplies within the said fund and class.

Section 2 - This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its publication in the manner provided by law.
