

ORDINANCE NO. 296

AN ORDINANCE providing for the zoning of a certain portion of the City of Redmond from R-60 to R-G classification.

WHEREAS, the owners of the below described real property located in the Town of Redmond (Now City of Redmond), King County, Washington, did petition the Town of Redmond for zoning of said property from R-60 to R-G classification; and

WHEREAS, said petition was referred to the Town Planning Commission, which Commission, having duly held a public hearing on August 6, 1958, in accordance with the requirements of law, did favorably report the petition to the Town Council; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council, having determined on the 13th day of August, 1958, that zoning of said property from R-60 to R-G classification should be granted with the qualification that the R-G zoning be for multiple housing only and that an ordinance thereon be drafted, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 - The following described real property located in the City of Redmond, King County, Washington, is hereby zoned from R-60 to R-G classification:

The east 150 feet of that portion of the north half of the north half of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section 1, township 25 north, range 5 east, W.M., lying westerly of 166th Avenue Northeast (also known as tract 5, Redmond Garden Tracts, an unrecorded plat)

subject to the qualification that the R-G classification is hereby granted for multiple housing only, and the action of the Town Council of the Town of Redmond taken on August 13, 1958, at a regular meeting thereof is hereby ratified and confirmed to such intents and purposes.


Section 2 - This Ordinance shall take effect on Nov. 6, 1962.

day of October, 1962.


