ordinance no. 3//

AN ORDINANCE, vacating certain alleys and public ways in the City of Redmond.

WHEREAS, a written Petition for Vacation of Alley was filed with the City Council on June 25, 1963 by the owners of all that property abutting upon the alleys and public ways therein described; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by Resolution No. 126, set the date of July 23, 1963, at 8:00 P.M., at the City Hall before the City Council as the time, place and authority for a public hearing to be held on said petition; and

WHEREAS, due and proper notice of such hearing has been made in accordance with law; and

WHEREAS, the hearing having been duly held, there being no objections by any of the abutting property owners, and the City Council having determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Redmond and the property owners concerned that such alleys and public ways be vacated, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 - That the petition be granted, and the following described alleys and public ways are hereby declared vacated:

The alley abutting Lots 1 through 9 and Lots 24 and 25, inclusive, Block 2, Sike's Third Addition to Redmond, according to plat thereof recorded in volume 21 of plats, page 37, records of King County, Washington; EXCEPT the north 16 feet of that portion of said alley adjoining said Lots 9 and 24.

Section 2 - This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof and APPROVED by the Mayor this 23rd day of July, 1963.
