ORDINANCE NO. 336

AN ORDINANCE, declaring an emergency in the Current Expense Fund (Library) under the general class Maintenance and Operation and providing for an expenditure in excess of the estimated expenditures in said fund and class; and providing for the issuance of emergency warrants.

WHEREAS, increase demands upon the library facilities of the City have necessitated a move to different quarters in order to provide more suitable and adequate library services for the needs of the community; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that an emergency therefor exists in the ability of the City to provide adequate library services and that such condition can be alleviated by the expenditure of funds in the estimated amount of \$ 3000. • for the rental of new library quarters in the Redmond First Building, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That an emergency is hereby declared to exist which could not reasonably have been forseen at the time the budget estimates were made, requiring an expenditure of \$ 3000. . in funds not provided for in said budget, and the expenditure of \$ 3000. See is hereby authorized out of the Current Expense Fund (Library) under the general class Maintenance and Operation in order to provide for said emergency.

Section 2. Said emergency expenditure shall be paid by the issuance of emergency warrants to be paid from any moneys on hand in the City Treasury in the Current Expense Fund not otherwise appropriated, or if there be insufficient money on hand in such fund,

Section 3. The publication of a copy of this ordinance in accordance with RCW 35.33.090 prior to its adoption shall constitute publication of the ordinance under the requirements of RCW 35.24.220, provided no changes have been made in the proposed ordinance upon its adoption.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect on June 1, 1964
