## ORDINANCE NO. 341

AN ORDINANCE vacating a portion of N.E. 28th Street, in the City of Redmond, Washington.

WHEREAS, a written Petition for Vacation of Street signed by all of the property owners abutting on the street therein described, was filed with the City Clerk and was presented to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by Resolution No. 139, set the date of August 25, 1964 at 8:00 P.M., at the City Hall, before the City Council as the time, place and authority for a public hearing to be held on said petition; and

WHEREAS, due and proper notice of such hearing has been made in accordance with law; and

WHEREAS, the hearing having been duly held, there being no objections made or filed by any of the abutting property owners, and the City Council having determined it is in the best interest of the City of Redmond and the property owners concerned that such street and public way be vacated, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the petition be granted, and the following described street and public way is hereby declared vacated:

That portion of N.E. 28th Street lying westerly from 180th Avenue N.E. and described as follows:

The north 30 feet of the west 623.22 feet of the east 653.22 feet of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section 24, township 25 north, range 5 east, W.M., situated in the City of Redmond, King County, Washington.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner required by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington at a regular meeting thereof and APPROVED by the Mayor this 25th day of August, 1964.
