

ORDINANCE NO. 362

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SALARIES AND WAGES FOR CERTAIN OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AND REPEALING AN ORDINANCE NO. 323, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1964.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following salaries and wage scales are hereby established for the respective positions of the employees and officials of the City of Redmond, Washington:

Maintenance Assistant, Grade 1	2.80	hourly

Section 2. Ordinance No. 323, effective January 1, 1964, is hereby repealed, except that the salaries therein established for elected officials shall remain in force during the remaining tenures of office for incumbent officials.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect on the 1st day of January 1965.

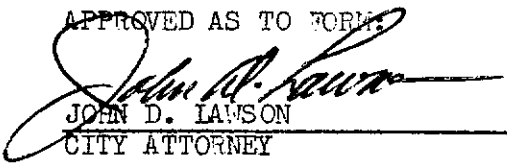
