

ORDINANCE NO. 364

AN ORDINANCE, vacation a portion of 168th Avenue N.E., in the City of Redmond.

WHEREAS, a written Petition for Vacation of Street, signed by all of the property owners abutting thereon, was filed with the City Clerk and was presented to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by Resolution No. 146, set the date of December 22, 1964, at 8:00 P.M., at the City Hall before the City Council as the time, place and authority for a public hearing to be held on said petition; and

WHEREAS, due and proper notice of such hearing has been made in accordance with law; and

WHEREAS, the hearing having been duly held, there being no objections by any of the abutting property owners, and the City Council having determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Redmond and the property owners concerned that such street and public way be vacated, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the petition be granted, and the following described street and public way is hereby declared vacated:

That portion of 168th Avenue N.E., lying southerly of the easterly extension of the south R.O.W. margin of N.E. 89th Street, and northerly of the north margin of N.E. 88th Street, situated in the City of Redmond, King County, Washington.

Provided, That the City of Redmond hereby reserves for itself and for the public, a 20 foot easement for the installation and maintenance of public utilities over and across said vacated street, lying 10 feet on each side of the centerline of said street.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 12 day of January, 1965.
