

ORDINANCE NO. 376

AN ORDINANCE, creating and establishing a special fund or account to be known as the "Claims Fund" and providing for the administration thereof.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a Claims Fund should be established in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 27, Laws of 1953 (RCW 35.21.085-086), NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby created and established a special fund to be known as the "Claims Fund" into which shall be paid and/or transferred moneys from the various departmental funds of the City and from which warrants may be issued and paid in payment of claims against the City for any purpose.

Section 2. The accounts of the City shall be so kept that they shall show the department or departments chargeable and the respective amounts for which each warrant is issued in payment of claims against the City.

Section 3. Transfers from an insolvent fund to the Claims Fund shall be by warrant and, upon the warrant being registered in the manner provided by law, such warrant shall be sold by the Claims Fund to obtain the moneys with which to pay the respective claim. Such warrant may be sold to any solvent fund of the City, or the same may be sold outside of City funds in the usual manner by the City Treasurer.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.
