

ORDINANCE NO. 383

AN ORDINANCE, relating to and regulating the stopping, standing and parking of vehicles upon certain streets within the City of Redmond.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In order to relieve traffic congestion and facilitate the orderly movement and safety of traffic, as provided in Section 96 of the Traffic Code (Ordinance No. 304), the stopping, standing and parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited at all times upon those portions of the following streets:

N.E. 77th Street	North	Centerline of 168th Ave. N.E.	200 feet westerly

N.E. 79th Street	North	Centerline of 164th Ave. N.E.	150 feet east
N.E. 80th Street	South	Centerline of 161st Ave. N.E.	260 feet east
Avondale Road	North	Centerline of Redmond Way	220 feet easterly

Section 2. The city traffic engineer, in conjunction with state highway authorities on those portions of such streets forming a part of the state highway system and as provided in Section 98 of the Traffic Code (Ordinance No. 304), shall cause appropriate signs to be erected on such streets, giving notice of the prohibition of parking thereon. When official signs are so erected and placed, no person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle in violation of the restrictions stated on such signs.

Section 3. This ordinance shall constitute a part of the Traffic Code of the City of Redmond (Ordinance No. 304) and the penalties provided in Section 112 thereof shall apply to violations hereunder.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law, subject to approval by the state highway commission as to those portions of such streets forming a part of the state highway system.
