

ORDINANCE NO. 394

AN ORDINANCE, vacating a portion of County Road No. 966, within the City of Redmond, Washington.

WHEREAS, a written Petition for the Vacation of Street, signed by in excess of two-thirds of the property owners abutting thereon, was filed with the City Clerk and presented to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by Resolution No. 158, set the date of February 23, 1966, at 8:00 P.M., at the City Hall, before the City Council, as the time, place and authority for a public hearing to be held on said Petition; and

WHEREAS, due and proper notice of such hearing has been made in accordance with law; and

WHEREAS, the hearing having been duly held, there being no objections by any of the abutting property owners, and the City Council having determined that it is in the best interest of the City and the property owners concerned that such street and public way be vacated, NOW, THEREFORE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Petition be granted, and the following described street and public way is hereby declared vacated:

That portion of County Road No. 966 (AKA Northrup Road No. 1431, AKA N.E. 18th Place, AKA Howard Road) in the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section 26, township 25 north, range 5 east, W.M., lying easterly of a line 20 feet east of, measured at right angles, and parallel with, the easterly right-of-way margin of 148th Avenue N.E. (AKA Road No. 334); and southerly of a line 30 feet south of and parallel to the north line of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of said section 26.

SUBJECT TO an easement for ingress and egress over the following described portion of the vacated street:

That portion of County Road No. 966 (AKA Northrup Road No. 1431, AKA N.E. 18th Place, AKA Howard Road) lying within the easterly 40 feet of the westerly 280 feet, of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of said section 26; LESS the north 30 feet.

Situated in the City of Redmond, King County, Washington.

The vacated street and easement are shown in the attached drawing, marked "Exhibit A", which is incorporated herein as a part of this ordinance.


Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 23rd day of February, 1966

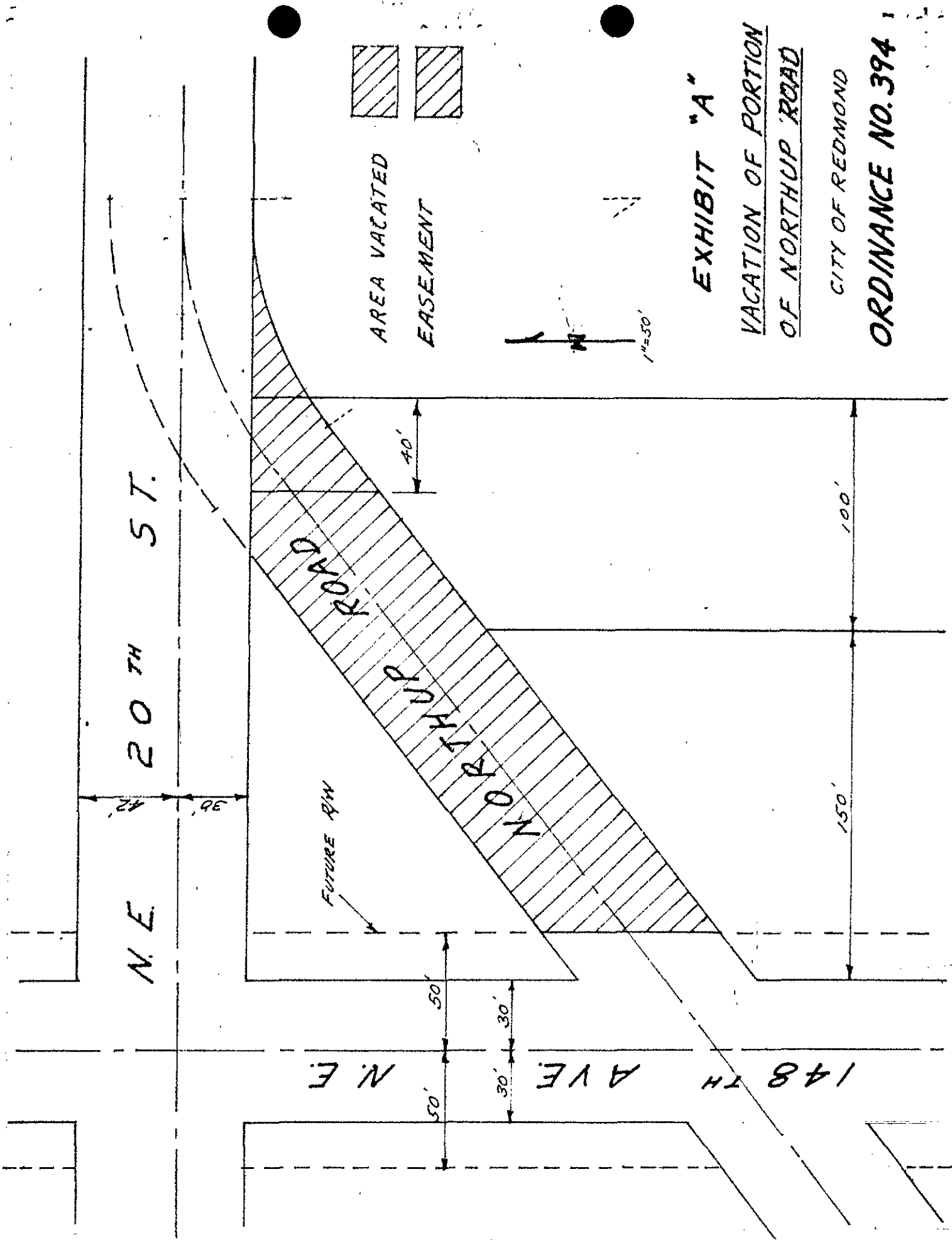


EXHIBIT "A"
