

ORDINANCE NO. 397

AN ORDINANCE, relating to motor vehicles and traffic; and establishing speed limits on certain streets within the City of Redmond, Washington.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined on the basis of engineering and traffic investigation studies that the maximum speed limits on the following streets and highways should be established at a rate of speed greater than that provided in Section 1, Chapter 16, Laws of 1963 for streets and highways within incorporated cities; Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following maximum speed limits indicated in miles per hour (MPH) are hereby established as the reasonable and safe maximum speed limits to be effective at all times upon those streets and highways listed:

Redmond Way (AKA Redmond-Kirkland Road) (SR 522 & 901)	Westbound	Sammamish River Bridge	Willows Rd. Inter.	40MPH
Redmond-Woodinville Road (SR 522)	Both Ways	N.E. 87th Street	N.E. 102nd Street	40MPH

Section 2. The City Traffic Engineer, in conjunction with State Highway authorities on those portions of such streets forming a part of the State Highway System and as provided in Section 39 of the Traffic Code (Ordinance No. 304), shall cause appropriate signs to be erected on such streets and highways, giving notice of the altered speed limit.


Section 3. This Ordinance shall constitute a part of the Traffic Code of the City of Redmond (Ordinance No. 304) and the penalties provided in Section 112 thereof shall apply to violations of the posted maximum speed limit hereunder.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law, subject to approval by the State Highway Commission as to those portions forming a part of the State Highway System.
