

ORDINANCE NO. 404

AN ORDINANCE, relating to the regulation and licensing of cabaret dances; and amending Sec. 2, Ordinance No. 253.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 253, passed February 8, 1961, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to operate or conduct a cabaret dance within the City of Redmond without first having obtained and being the holder of a valid and subsisting license so to do, to be known as a "Cabaret Dance License." The fee for any such Cabaret Dance License shall be as follows:

Single Dance	\$ <u>25.00</u>
Annual Dance	\$ <u>350.00</u>


The annual license fee shall be payable in two installments on January 1 and July 1 of the applicable calendar year. The entire license fee shall be payable for the applicable year regardless of when the application for license is made and shall not be prorated for any part of the year except by action of the City Council.

No license to conduct a cabaret dance shall be granted unless the applicant therefor be of good moral character.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect July 1, 1966.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 28<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1966.
