

ORDINANCE NO. 418

AN ORDINANCE, revoking a franchise granted to Colorcable, Inc., a Washington corporation, for non-compliance; and repealing Ordinance No. 395.

WHEREAS, Colorcable, Inc., a Washington corporation, was duly granted a franchise to construct, operate and maintain a coaxial cable subscriber system for television signal distribution throughout the City of Redmond, Washington, by Ordinance No. 395, adopted March 22, 1966; and

WHEREAS, Section 14 of said ordinance provided that the rights and privileges granted would cease and terminate and the ordinance would be of no further force or effect unless the grantee started actual construction of its system within six months from the effective date of the ordinance, to wit: within six months from April 5, 1966, the effective date of the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, an investigation and report has been made by the Public Works Director that no construction has been performed by Colorcable, Inc., of its system within the City of Redmond within six months from April 5, 1966 or at any other time; and notice of the non-compliance of the requirement of Section 14 of said ordinance has been duly sent to grantee; Now, Therefore,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the franchise heretofore granted to Colorcable, Inc., a Washington corporation, by Ordinance No. 395, to construct, operate and maintain a coaxial cable subscriber system for television signal distribution throughout the City of Redmond, Washington, is hereby revoked for non-compliance with the requirement of starting actual construction within six months of the effective date of said ordinance.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 395, adopted March 22, 1966, is hereby repealed.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 10th day of January, 1967.
