

Meeting Time Change

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 440

AN ORDINANCE, relating to meetings of the City Council; and amending Section 1 of Ordinance No. 283.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 283, passed March 28, 1962, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Regular Meetings. Regular meetings of the City Council of the City of Redmond shall be held on the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month at 7:30 P.M., beginning Tuesday, May 8, 1962; provided, however, that should any such meeting fall upon a day designated as a legal holiday, such meeting shall be held at the same hour on the next succeeding business day not a holiday, excluding Saturdays and Sundays; provided, further, that the hour set for such meetings shall be 8:00 P.M. instead of 7:30 P.M. during the period established by RCW 1.20.051 for daylight saving time.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law. The meeting time change shall be in effect beginning with the regular meeting on June 13, 1967.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 23rd day of May, 1967.
